**2001° Pauletts Andreas Shiraz - 93 points**

Vintage conditions in 2001 suited reds in Clare, and many concentrated, balanced wines have now emerged. With all the hype surrounding 2002 rieslings, other wines have been pushed into the background – which means that many good 2001 wines are readily available. This flagship red from Pauletts has a very concentrated, fragrant nose, with lots of plum fruit. The palate is well-proportioned; liquorice, meat and smoky charred wood nicely layered around the fruit flavours. Tannins are ripe, dense, sturdy and balanced; it will age well for a decade.
