Paulett's top shiraz is named in honour of Andreas Weiman, who purchased this Clare Valley property in 1866. It is an exotically aromatic shiraz with complex aromas of spice, woodsmoke, mint, bitter chocolate, currants and dark berries. The palate is lush and concentrated with rich, long flavours and harmoniously integrated ripe tannins.
